#### <u>THIS MONTH MEETING— JUN 11TH. OUR SERGIO— LECTURE DEMO ON</u> JAPANESE MAPLES — WORKSHOP

We are fortunate to be having our very own Sergio Cuan as a visiting artist who will be giving a special talk about growing Japanese Maples as bonsai. This is a great opportunity to learn a lot from an award winning artist (one of his trees was selected as best tree by the American Bonsai Society a few years ago) about these wonderful beautiful trees. What varieties are best and how to get them. How do you develop trees from cuttings. What is J maples year round care requirements and what are the specific techniques that eventually develop a mind blowing tree. Much of what is said may well be applicable to other deciduous trees as well, so this is a very useful meeting, NOT TO BE MISSED!

The afternoon session will be an open workshop for BYO trees, preferably any maple, please bring in any that you have. Other species are also welcome but Peter Sobel recently brought back about twenty tropicals, which he purchased for the club from Florida. These are mostly small ficus, but there are other species as well. Peter says they have real potential. They will be available at cost (\$20 -\$30) to members who can start initial styling in the afternoon session. Trees which are not sold will stay as club trees and will be developed by our members for later sale to the public as part of our plan to increase membership in Bergen Bonsai.

The June meeting will be interesting so make sure you attend.

## <u>NEXT MONTH MEETING — JULY 16TH. — FREE WORKSHOP ON TROPICALS—</u> <u>BYO MATERIAL</u>

Tropical bonsai like tropical weather and around mid July is the earliest time of the year for hot and muggy days and nights. And since tropical bonsai are then growing at their greatest rates, July is also the best time to repot these trees. How fortunate (or planned) then that our July meeting is all about a workshop on tropical trees, but especially about repotting. Please bring in your healthy warm weather trees along with pots, soil, some wire and tools, the club will supply the expertise and the workshop is free.

Now remember those twenty or so trees that Peter brought back from Florida? Those that are bought can be worked on in this workshop and those that are not sold will be developed by members for sale to the larger population. So work on your own trees or the club's, but to work.
